
- Semester-long program in the nation's capital

Environmental Health Intern


- Research priority issues in public health in United States

Congressional Intern OR Committee Intern


- Conduct legislative research in areas of your interest (i.e healthcare, STEM research funding, LGBTQ+ health, etc.)






- Simply apply for UCDC and work in any organization of your choice (STEM)
